

**After two years, he escaped and made his way back to France, where he served in a rural parish. Suddenly, Vincent saw the poverty around him that he hadn't noticed before. He sought financial help in his former wealthy circles and eventually began organizing friends and associates into groups who went from house to house asking for donations of furniture, food and clothing.**

**Vincent was also beginning to connect his former focus on wealth and fame with a weak foundation in faith. He founded an order of priests, the Vincentians, whose members received thorough spiritual instruction and pledged to devote their lives to the spiritual and material needs of the poor. In his final years, Vincent ministered to prisoners and slaves, sharing his own story of hope as a former slave.**
